



STILL THE DRIVING FORCE A DECADE ON

EduCity, a catalyst development driven by Iskandar Investment Berhad, is a fully integrated education hub which not only grooms the next generation of leaders, but most importantly, acts as a feeder of talents to support Iskandar Malaysia's various economic activities.

After a decade, the multi-campus education hub which houses some of the world's most established institutions in academia is still recognised as the driving-force behind the socio-economic development in Malaysia.

All degrees and credentials given out at each branch of our international universities are of the same recognition as that awarded to students at the main campuses overseas.

In other words, Malaysians students and students from Asia can get an internationally recognised qualification from highly respected universities at EduCity for a fraction of the price.

Back in 2011, the 300-acre site was joined by Newcastle University Medicine Malaysia. It now houses more institutions and schools from both locals and international brand names namely University of Southampton Malaysia, Multimedia University, University of Reading Malaysia,

Netherlands Maritime Institute of Technology, Management Development Institute of Singapore and Raffles University. The ecosystem is completed with two international school located off campus, namely Raffles American School and Marlborough College Malaysia.

EduCity also provides student accommodation at the Student Village. A 12½ storey building comprising of 210 hostel type rooms and 66 units apartment, the facility is able to cater up to 640 students at a time.

Beyond this, recreational facilities are also afforded at the EduCity Sports Complex, where a Main Outdoor Stadium features an IAAF-certified athletics track and a full-sized football pitch. The sports complex has a 500-seater Aquatic Centre with an Olympic size pool and a 1,500-seat Indoor Arena that caters for multiple sports activities and events. Within the compound of the sports complex there are outdoor tennis courts, volleyball and futsal courts, as well as a gymnasium.
